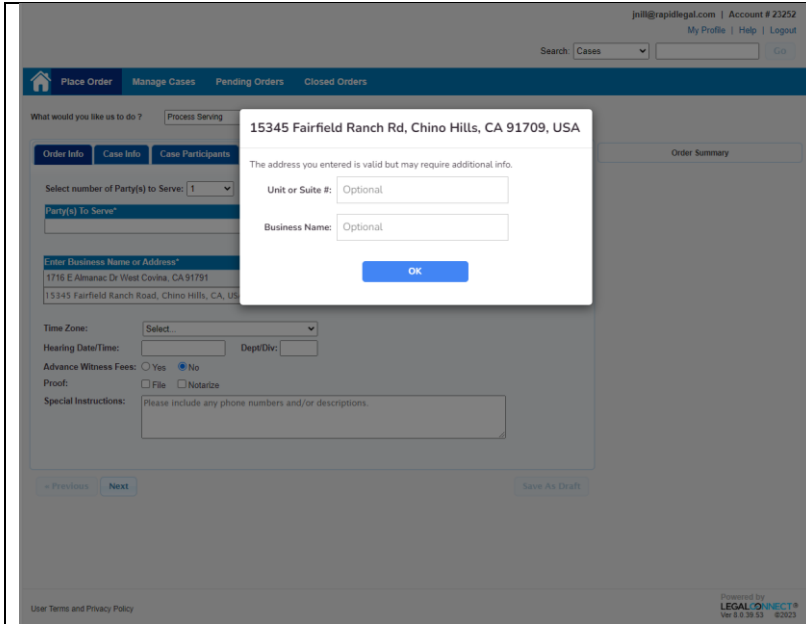

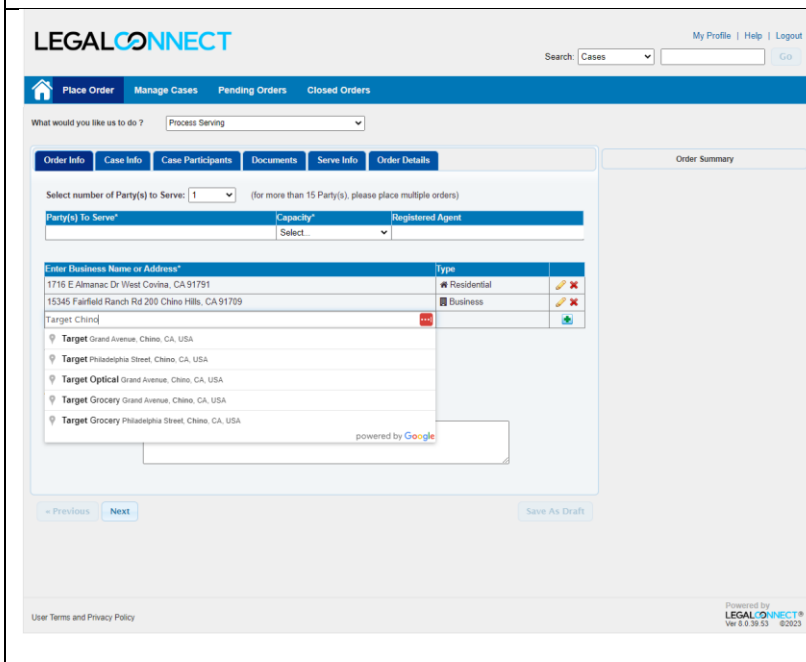
Once an address is selected, it will be validated for accuracy and completeness.
